AUTHORITY FOR THE MANUAL

In compliance with applicable sections of the *Arizona Revised Statutes* and by virtue of the authority vested in it by the president and Board of Regents, the ASU Department of Public Safety hereby adopts these rules, regulations, procedures, and instructions for the maintenance of public peace, safety, and order on the campuses and properties of Arizona State University.

All rules of conduct, policies, procedures, instructions, and philosophies are within established administrative authority, as provided by applicable statutes and are incumbent on all members of the university community.

Through the director of public safety, Arizona State University reserves the right to amend or revoke any of the contained rules, policies, regulations, and instructions or incorporate additional ones as circumstances or the good of the university community may require.

PUBLIC SAFETY EVALUATION RESPONSIBILITY

The director of the ASU Department of Public Safety shall have the responsibility to ensure the safety of the university community. The final authority for determining the public safety conditions of Arizona State University, identifying existing public safety hazards, and establishing the appropriate corrective actions shall rest with the director. All matters affecting the public safety condition of the university shall be directed to the director.
