Policy	Summary of Changes
<p>PTS 001 Introduction</p>	<p>Revision of Policy Revised to change "decal" to "permit" and to update the locations where PTS annually publishes the <i>Parking Rules and Regulations</i></p>
<p>PTS 101 Parking Permit Sales and Vehicle Registration</p>	<p>Revision of Policy Revised to reflect that a <i>Parking Permit Guide</i> will be issued along with a receipt after issuing a parking permit</p>
<p>PTS 103 Permits for Persons with Disabilities</p>	<p>Revision of Policy Revised to include PTS Customer Service contact information</p>
<p>PTS 104 Special "A" Permits, Gold Permits, All Access Campus Permits, Faculty Multi-Campus Permit, and Vendor Permits</p>	<p>Revision of Policy Revised to include Faculty Multi-campus permits, and to update locations where permits are allowed to park on the Tempe and Downtown campuses</p>
<p>PTS 105 Replacement of Lost, Damaged, or Stolen Transit Passes, Permits, and Gate Access Cards</p>	<p>Revision of Policy Revised to clarify that permit holders would have to pay a replacement fee for unreturned transit passes, permits, and gate access cards. If applicable, an ASU ID card would need to be presented</p>
<p>PTS 303 Towing of Illegally Parked Vehicles</p>	<p>Revision of Policy Revised to include that parking an electric vehicle charging stall with a nonelectric vehicle or with an electric vehicle but not actively charging is subject to being booted or towed</p>
<p>PTS 401 Parking Citations Appeals</p>	<p>Revision of Policy Revised to include e-mail as a way for appellant to submit an appeal, and that PTS has the option to void a citation under appeal</p>
<p>PTS 501 Commuter Options Program</p>	<p>Revision of Policy Revised to remove "Based on available resources" under the ASU Commuter Options Program Services header, and to add high pollution advisories as a program service</p>
<p>PTS 601 Transit Services</p>	<p>Revision of Policy Revised to remove "free" shuttle services; to note that transit rules state that passengers cannot drink except from closed containers; to add a new header for intercampus shuttles with itemized information, and a Web site to find Valley Metro bus routes; and to remove specific routes</p>
