<p>PTS 101</p> <p>Parking Permit Sales and Vehicle Registration</p>	<p>Revision of Policy</p> <p>Revised to clarify that all vehicles must be registered at all times, not just annually; to state that payment for parking permits can be made online except for cash and check transactions, which must be handled in person; and to delete the statement that all Arizona residents must obtain Arizona vehicle registration before obtaining a parking permit</p>
<p>PTS 103</p> <p>Permits for Persons with Disabilities</p>	<p>Revision of Policy</p> <p>Revised to state that health attendant parking permits may be purchased for attendants assisting a disabled student living in a residence hall</p>
<p>PTS 104</p> <p>Special “A” Permits, Gold Permits, All Access Campus Permits, and Vendor Permits</p>	<p>Revision of Policy</p> <p>Revised to correct the spelling of the NHI parking structure; to add the South Zone lot on the West Campus to the Emeriti and Retiree Permits section; and to add a section on Vendor Golf Cart Permits</p>
<p>PTS 203</p> <p>Events Parking</p>	<p>Revision of Policy</p> <p>Revised to include a statement that a Facility Use Agreement may be required by Parking and Transit Services and to provide links to the policy regarding that agreement</p>
<p>PTS 301</p> <p>Parking Citations</p>	<p>Revision of Policy</p> <p>Revised to clarify that parking citation recipients need to appeal a citation within the allotted timeframe and to change the definition for Signed or Signing to include notification procedures if restrictions to</p>

parking spaces are altered

Revised to clarify that a vehicle can be towed with no warning in a situation determined by PTS management to be hazardous and that a dean's referral will be issued for a student who commits any of the listed violations or repeat violations

Revised to change the time of notification of an appellant about the date and time of the next board meeting from 24 hours to one week

Revision of Policy
