<p><u>STA 106-04</u></p> <p>Insurance Requirements for International Students</p>	<p>Revision of Policy</p> <p>Renumbered from STA 1006-04; revised to state that international students are required to purchase ASU health insurance and to detail the conditions and procedures for waiver of this requirement</p>
<p><u>STA 202-02</u></p> <p>Career Services Eligibility</p>	<p>Revision of Policy</p> <p>Revised to extend eligibility to current dues paying members of the ASU Alumni Association</p>
<p><u>STA 202-06</u></p> <p>Eligibility for On-Campus Recruiting</p>	<p>Revision of Policy</p> <p>Revised to extend eligibility to current dues paying members of the ASU Alumni Association</p>

<p><u>STA 301-03</u></p> <p>Testing Services</p>	<p>New Policy</p> <p>Describes the career and clinical testing services provided by Counseling and Consultation</p>

<p><u>STA 301-04</u></p> <p>Consultation and Outreach</p>	<p>New Policy</p> <p>Describes the service goals of Counseling and Consultation</p>
<p><u>STA 301-05</u></p> <p>Eating Disorders Program</p>	<p>New Policy</p> <p>Describes the program and services available to students with eating disorders</p>
<p><u>STA 301-06</u></p> <p>Career Counseling and Testing Program</p>	<p>New Policy</p> <p>Describes career planning options available from Counseling and Consultation</p>
<p><u>STA 302-03</u></p> <p>Mental Health Emergencies</p>	<p>Revision of Policy</p> <p>Revised to update the procedures for providing mental health emergency service to students living on-campus</p>
<p><u>STA 302-06</u></p> <p>Personal Consultation</p>	<p>New Policy</p> <p>Describes the use of personal consultation to assess a student's needs for professional services</p>
<p><u>STA 302-07</u></p> <p>Referral Procedure</p>	<p>New Policy</p> <p>Describes the procedure for referring students for professional services offered outside Counseling and Consultation</p>
<p><u>STA 302-08</u></p> <p>Counseling Fees</p>	<p>New Policy</p> <p>Describes the fees for clinical services offered by Counseling and Consultation</p>
<p><u>STA 302-09</u></p> <p>Student Confidentiality</p>	<p>New Policy</p> <p>Describes the procedure for maintaining client confidentiality in Counseling and Consultation</p>
<p><u>STA 302-10</u></p> <p>Informed Consent</p>	<p>New Policy</p> <p>Describes the policy of informed consent and lists the services that require a signed informed consent form</p>

<p><u>STA 502-01</u></p> <p>General Building Rules</p>	<p>Revision of Policy</p> <p>Revised to restrict the movement of furniture within the Memorial Union</p>
<p><u>STA 502-02</u></p> <p>Reserving and Using Memorial Union Facilities</p>	<p>Revision of Policy</p> <p>Revised to add an e-mail address for reserving rooms in the Memorial Union, to change the dates during which off-campus groups can reserve space from “predetermined” to “as available,” and to define where, when, and how signage or decorations may be used in the MU</p>
<p><u>STA 502-06</u></p> <p>Petitioning and Distributing and Posting Literature</p>	<p>Revision of Policy</p> <p>Revised to withdraw the use of bulletin boards within the Memorial Union</p>
<p><u>STA 502-07</u></p> <p>Lost and Found Items</p>	<p>Revision of Policy</p> <p>Revised to change the 60-day limit for holding found items in the Memorial Union to 90 days</p>
<p><u>STA 502-09</u></p> <p>Locker Use</p>	<p>Revision of Policy</p> <p>Revised to restrict the use of lockers within the Memorial Union to a daily basis and to increase the fee for reclaiming property to \$10</p>
<p><u>STA 502-11</u></p> <p>Vending Machine Refunds</p>	<p>Revision of Policy</p> <p>Revised to include all vending machines on campus</p>
<p><u>STA 503-03</u></p> <p>Sparky’s Den Recreation Center</p>	<p>Revision of Policy</p> <p>Revised to update the name of the policy to the name change of the center</p>
<p><u>STA 602-09</u></p> <p>Withdrawal from Classes for Medical/Compassionate Reasons</p>	<p>Revision of Policy</p> <p>Revised to stress that medical withdrawal is to be used only in extraordinary circumstances and to state that the dean’s designee may impose conditions before granting readmission</p>
<p><u>STA 802-03</u></p>	<p>Revision of Policy</p>

<p>Enrollment Equivalencies</p>	<p>Revised to remove Stafford loans from the policy</p>
<p>STA 802-12 Summer Aid Awarding Guidelines</p>	<p>Revision of Policy Revised to remove Stafford loans from the guidelines</p>
<p>STA 802-13 Financial Aid Reviews</p>	<p>Revision of Policy Revised to remove items that are no longer considered for review in adjustments to a student’s household or income information</p>
<p>STA 1002-09 Involuntary Withdrawal from the University in Special Circumstances</p>	<p>Revision of Policy Revised to include the possibility of readmission under specific conditions and to include contacting parents subject to FERPA guidelines</p>
<p>STA 1006-04 Insurance Requirements for International Students</p>	<p>Renumbering of Policy Policy renumbered to STA 106-04</p>
