Elective Course Descriptions (SAMPLE)

<u>Grammar Courses</u>	<u>Description</u>
Basic 1 Grammar	Learn and review helping verbs, pronouns, adjectives, count/non-count nouns, and tenses (present, present progressive, and simple past).
Basic 2 Grammar	Learn grammar for everyday writing and speaking: present, progressive, and future tenses, irregular verbs in the past tense, modal verbs, pronouns, order of adjectives, and comparisons.
Intermediate 1 Grammar	Improve grammar for everyday writing and conversation: present perfect, present perfect continuous, and future tenses, noun clauses, and grammar to cover frequency, duration, possibility, and necessity.
Intermediate 2 Grammar	Focus on an overview of all the tenses. This course also covers passive voice and sequence of tenses with adverbial clauses.
Advanced Grammar	Explore complex sentence structure, participial phrases, reduced adjective clauses and appositives, infinitives and gerunds, hypothetical conditionals, and the subjunctive.

<u>Communication Courses</u>	<u>Description</u>
Basic Everyday English	Learn basic American English for everyday communication. This course is based on a large database (Cambridge International Corpus of North American English) of everyday conversations.
Intermediate Everyday English	Learn intermediate American English for everyday communication. This course is based on a large database (Cambridge International Corpus of North American English) of everyday conversations.
Advanced Everyday English	Learn advanced American English for everyday communication. This course is based on a large database (Cambridge International Corpus of North American English) of everyday conversations.

<u>Business Courses</u>	<u>Description</u>
International Business – English for Global Business	Study English for Global Business emphasizing oral communication skills.
Business Presentations	Learn essential presentation skills that will help in business careers and life.

<u>American Culture Courses</u>	<u>Description</u>
American Pronunciation & Accent Reduction	Improve comprehensibility and comprehension through explanation, demonstration, and practice of the English sound system. Learn tongue and mouth positions, vowels and consonants, stress, rhythm, and intonation.
American Music	Explore American Music to improve listening, speaking, pronunciation, and vocabulary.
Vocabulary Power	Develop an active vocabulary of commonly used words in general and academic English.
The American University – Bridge to ASU	Learn ways to study, survive, and succeed in college. This course is an introduction to the American University.

<u>Science, Technology & Sustainability</u>	<u>Description</u>
English for Sustainability and the Environment	Arizona State University is a leader in sustainability, and has established the world’s first School of Sustainability. AECP offers possibly the only U.S. language course focused on Sustainability and the Environment. Improve English language skills by discussing contemporary environmental issues as well as what it will take to sustain future life on Earth. Take field trips to “green” buildings and work on research projects dealing with such topics as water resources, renewable energy, population growth, Native American Environmental practices, recycled building materials, and life in a desert community.

<u>Test Preparation Courses</u>	<u>Description</u>
Intermediate TOEFL Preparation	Experience an introduction to test-taking strategies for the iBT TOEFL. This class meets three hours per week. Only Intermediate level students may attend this class.
Advanced Intensive TOEFL Preparation	Enhance test-taking strategies for specific areas of the iBT TOEFL and the paper and pencil TOEFL. This is a super-intensive elective course and meets six hours per week. Only Advanced level students may attend this class.
