Dan Devine



Dan Devine, the coaching legend who led Arizona State to a 27-3-1 record in 1955-57, and who later coached Missouri, Notre Dame and the Green Bay Packers, passed away May 9 at his Valley home after a long illness. He was 77.

Devine was hired by Arizona State College at the age of 31 and coached the Sun Devils to records of 8-2-1, 9-1 and 10-0 in his three seasons. During the 9-1 season, ASU lost only to Texas Western, and except for that game never scored less than 19 points a game all season.

The following year ASU achieved its highest ranking to that point at No. 12 after an undefeated season. The Devils had four shutouts and won all but one game by double digits.

Devine then moved on to Missouri in 1958. With the Tigers he was 93-37-7 in 13 seasons, winning two Big Eight championships and appearing in six bowls. Missouri never lost more than three games a season during his tenure, and won the 1961 Orange Bowl, 1963 Bluebonnet Bowl, 1966 Sugar Bowl and the 1969 Gator Bowl.

At Green Bay he coached the Packers to the NFC Central title in 1972 with a 10-4 record. While there, he won Coach of the Year honors from the Pro Football Writers and United Press International.

It was at Notre Dame, however, where he found fame and glory after replacing Ara Parseghian in 1975.

Dandy Dan coached the 11-1 1977 Fighting Irish to the national championship, beating previously undefeated Texas, 38-10, in the Cotton Bowl. In five seasons, the Irish was 53-16-1 and won two other bowl games. Devine was NFL Hall of Fame quarterback Joe Montana's college coach, and it was Joe and defensive tackle Bob Golic who led the Irish to the '77 crown.

When Devine left coaching in 1980, he returned to ASU as executive director of the Sun Angel Foundation, and in 1987 accepted a position to direct an upstart ASU program designed to combat substance abuse.

Devine was born Dec. 23, 1924, in Augusta, Wis. He earned a bachelor's degree in history from Minnesota-Duluth in 1948 and a master's degree in guidance and counseling from Michigan State.

Devine's wife, Joanne, died Dec. 19, 2000. They were married in 1947 and are survived by seven children.

Stephen C. Farris

Stephen C. Farris a former first vice president of the Arizona State College Alumni Association and a longtime Phoenix resident, died August 1st at the age of eighty-one. During World War II, Steve served in Europe as a bombardier, receiving a Purple Heart, Distinguished Flying Cross and Air Medal. Upon returning, he was graduated from ASC in 1947 where he was a TKE and elected student body president. He is survived by his wife, Norma; daughter, Tricia; son-in-law, David; sisters, Ima, Martha and Nelle and his extended family, including, Mark, Ann, Lindsay, Taylor, Matt, Melinda, Scott, Monique and Kelly.

Glenn Peterson

Glenn Peterson, an Arizona State College graduate and a charter member of the Scottsdale Quarterback Club, passed away on Aug. 19 after a heart attack and by-pass surgery.

Peterson, 82, was born in Minnesota and moved to Arizona in 1924. He attended Loloma Elementary School and Scottsdale High School before enrolling at ASC. He served in the Navy during World War II and then returned to Scottsdale.

Peterson, in addition to his 39 years in the SQC, was a member of the Sun Angel Foundation and was a season ticket holder for ASU football, basketball and baseball.

Glenn Barlow

Glenn Barlow, 75, a former ASU basketball player and a member of the Sun Angel Foundation, passed away Sept. 13. Barlow was a husband, father, grandfather, great grandfather, schoolteacher, administrator, native Arizonan and American.

Barlow was also a football and basketball official for many years, officiating in the Western Athletic Conference and retiring when ASU went into the Pac-10. He is survived by his wife Sheila, sons Daniel, David, Dean, Don and Scott and daughter Michelle Smith. He also had nine grandchildren and two great grandsons.
