ASU lost a tremendous advocate June 19 when Blake Anderson '84 died of complications from lupus. He was 41.

Anderson, who tirelessly worked to build support for ASU at the Legislature, was pushing a \$440 million bill to fund research facilities at the state's universities. The bill passed the Legislature the day he died.

In an unprecedented tribute to a lobbyist, the Capitol flag was flown at half-staff.

His wife, Debbie, and three daughters Lindsey, 13, Emily, 10, and Julie, 7, survive him.
