

SAGE FAMILY SOUTHEAST ASIAN STUDIES SCHOLARSHIP

APPLICATION DEADLINE: 3 March 2008

The Center for Asian Research is pleased to announce the availability of the **SAGE FAMILY SOUTHEAST ASIAN STUDIES SCHOLARSHIP** for the 2007 - 2008 academic year. The Sage Family Southeast Asian Studies Scholarship is a tribute to William W. Sage's interest in and lifelong work in Laos and Southeast Asia and is in loving memory and honor of his parents, Lloyd G. and Twyla M. Sage. The purpose of the scholarship is to support travel and study abroad in Laos and Southeast Asia for undergraduate students in Southeast Asian Studies at Arizona State University.

Scholarship Award Amount: \$2,000/Summer or academic year
Scholarships Awarded Per Year: One (1)

To be eligible for the scholarship, an applicant must:

- Be admitted and enrolled as a full-time, undergraduate student (12 credit hours per semester), during the 2007-2008 academic year.
- Must be pursuing a Southeast Asia Studies Certificate or have completed at least one course focused primarily on Southeast Asia.
- Have a 2.75 or higher cumulative GPA .
- Have a demonstrated interest in Southeast Asia and use the scholarship to travel and study abroad in Laos and Southeast Asia.
- Financial need is not required but the student must be able to accept the entire scholarship amount in addition to, but not as a substitute for any other scholarship or grant that the student may receive. If receiving the scholarship reduces the student's eligibility to receive a loan, the student should be informed that this is a possibility.
- Must be willing to meet with the Donor once during the academic year.

Application Procedure (please submit in this order):

1. The completed Sage Family Southeast Asian Studies application (2 pages).
2. Attach a typewritten statement (1-2 pages, double-spaced) describing:
 - Personal and family background.
 - Education and career goals.
 - How this scholarship will assist in achieving your education and career goals.
3. Attach a copy of your most current transcript that includes grades from your most recently completed semester (unofficial copies are acceptable).
4. Attach two (2) letters of recommendation from professionals who can attest to the potential for success in academics at ASU and the character of the applicant.
