

Guidelines for Submission of Papers to Conference Publication

May 2007

Dear Paper Presenters at the Second International Conference on Lao Studies:

The following information is to guide the submission of your final paper for consideration in the volume to be published from the papers presented at the Second International Conference on Lao Studies. If submitted in other languages, an English version must accompany the submission. To ensure that your paper is considered for possible publication in the volume, please submit a camera-ready copy of your paper by September 1, 2007.

In order to maintain consistency in the format of papers from the triennial conferences, the Second International Conference will follow the author's guidelines used for the first conference. These guidelines were developed by the NIU Center for Southeast Asian Studies Publications Program and can be found at the following website:

These guidelines include information about in-text citations, references, style, and special terms. If you have questions about the format of your paper, please email KLAdams@asu.edu or Thomas.Hudak@asu.edu. Please do not ask the staff at NIU to help you as this publication is not their responsibility. We are only asking you to use their style and format guidelines for uniformity.

Papers should be single spaced, no longer than 20 pages, left and right margins should be set at 2.13 inches, top and bottom margins should be set at 1.75 inches, the paper's font size should be set at 11 pt., and the font size of the paper's title should be set at 12 pt. (Times New Roman font). This final format is described in the [Author's Guidelines](#), and you can see a [sample document](#) at the website. If you are using any special fonts such as Lao fonts or IPA, please attach the font files with your article when you e-mail the paper.

Papers will be carefully reviewed and revisions will be suggested. Please follow the guidelines and make the suggested revisions or we will not be able to publish your paper. To ensure inclusion in the volume, please submit a camera-ready copy of your paper by September 1, 2007.
