Bacclareate Degree Requirements

Semester Hours Required

A minimum of 120 semester hours and 45 upper division semester hours (300 and 400 level courses) are required for a bachelor's degree.

First Year Composition Requirement

Students must demonstrate reasonable proficiency in written English by achieving a grade of "C" or better in both ENG 101 and 102 or ENG 105 or their equivalents. Should a student receive a grade lower than "C" in any of the courses, it must be repeated until the specified proficiency is demonstrated.

COLLEGE GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

NOTE: These College requirements are separate from the University General Studies requirements. Only courses whose **prefixes** are specified in the following lists qualify as College Graduation courses.

Bridge Course Requirement

A list of approved bridge courses is available at: <http://asu.edu/clas/bridgecourses>. Unless otherwise noted, only the courses listed at this site may be used to satisfy the bridge course requirement. When taking special topics courses numbered 294, 394, or 494 to meet the bridge course requirement, you may only use courses with the same course prefix, number, and title as those on the list.

Humanities : Two courses of at least three hours each at the 300 level or higher from the following course prefixes:

AFH: African American Studies Program: AFH courses only

CSH: Department of Chicana/o Studies: CSH courses only

ENG: Department of English: **2001-02 Literature courses only**

2002-03 and beyond: any course at the 300 level or higher.

CHI, FLA, FRE, GER, HEB, ITA, JPN, KOR, LAT, POR, RUS, SCA, SPA: Department of Languages and Literatures: Any literature courses at the 300 level or above that are not also used to meet the **minimum** language proficiency requirement.

HUM: Interdisciplinary Humanities Program

HPS: School of Life Sciences

PHI: Department of Philosophy

REL: Department of Religious Studies

WSH: Women's Studies Program: WSH courses only

Natural Sciences and Mathematics: Two classes of at least three hours each from the following course prefixes:

Note: Students majoring in Anthropology, Geography and Psychology may not use courses from their major (ASM, GPH or PSY, respectively) to satisfy the Natural Sciences and Mathematics requirement.

ASM: Department of Anthropology

BIO, MIC, MBB, PLB: School of Life Sciences

CHM, BCH: Department of Chemistry and Biochemistry

CSE: Department of Computer Science

GPH: Department of Geography

GLG: Department of Geological Sciences

MAT, STP: Department of Mathematics and Statistics - Any course **above** the MAT 117 level.

PHY, AST, PHS: Department of Physics and Astronomy

PSY: Department of Psychology
