NOTES FOR MAJOR:

- A grade of C or better must be achieved in all courses to be counted toward the major or electives; Pass/Fail courses cannot be used for the major or electives.
- SPA 313 & SPA 314 (as well as SPA 315 & SPA 316) must be taken in sequence; SPA 315 & SPA 316 are designed for bilingual students.
- SPA 313 and SPA 314 are pre-requisites for SPA 412. Students testing out of SPA 313 & SPA 314 may register directly in SPA 412.
- SPA 420 is designed for Spanish majors going into education. (SPA 400 or equivalent is pre-requisite).
- Students must be admitted to the Translation Certificate Program to register in FLA 401, 481, 483, 483, 494.
