- A grade of C or better must be achieved in all courses must be achieved in all courses to be counted towards the major; A minimum of 12 upper - division hours in the major must be taken in residence at ASU-Tempe; Pass/Fail courses CANNOT be used for the major.
- SPA 311 & SPA 312 do not count towards the major in any catalog year.
- Students may substitute SPA 413, Advanced Spanish Grammar, for SPA 412, Advanced Conversation and Composition.
