Faculty admitted to the graduate Faculty in English must (1) hold an earned terminal degree in one of the fields covered by the department's graduate faculty (Literature, Linguistics, Rhetoric and Composition, English Education, or Creative Writing) or an appropriate cognate field; (2) demonstrate continuing high quality research or creative activity in one or more of these fields, typically through refereed publications appropriate to rank and career trajectory; (3) demonstrate a record of successful mentoring of graduate students at the Ph.D. level, either as chair or committee member; and (4) be willing to undertake such mentoring. Faculty endorsed to chair must also hold tenure.
