- A grade of C or better must be achieved in all courses must be achieved in all courses to be counted towards the major; A minimum of 12 upper -division hours in the major must be taken in residence at ASU-Tempe; Pass/Fail courses CANNOT be used for the major.
- Students may substitute SPA 413, Advanced Spanish Grammar, for SPA 412, Advanced Conversation and Composition. Notify [silcadvising@asu.edu](mailto:silcadvising@asu.edu) if you do this so that your D.A.R.S. report can be updated. Note that if you choose to take SPA 413 instead of SPA 412 courses which require SPA 412 as a prerequisite (such as SPA 400) still require SPA 412 and you would need instructor consent & instructor given override (see LL440 for that form) to be able to enroll.
- A maximum of 6 hours from SPA 471, 472 or 473 may apply to the Spanish Major (Literature/Culture Track)

\*\*Students may choose up to six hours of POR 400-level courses in literature or culture as part of their electives.
