Scholarship Requirements

1. Applicant should be in good standing with the local, state, and national levels of Gamma Beta Phi.

2. Applicant should be in attendance at the 2005 Gamma Beta Phi National Convention in Gatlinburg, TN.

3. A typed letter (double spaced, maximum length of two pages) must accompany the application and contain the following information:
 - A. Why do you think you deserve this scholarship? You may include such information as financial need, outstanding qualities, or dedication to the organization.

 - B. How will you use your Gamma Beta Phi experience after you graduate?

 - C. What does Gamma Beta Phi mean to you?

 - D. Any other information you believe is important.

4. In an outline form, complete on a separate sheet the following requirements:

A. Describe involvement in Gamma Beta Phi on the local, state, and national levels.

B. Describe the honors you have received from Gamma Beta Phi and/or other organizations.

5. A letter of recommendation from the chapter president, advisor, or executive committee should accompany the application.

6. Applicants should submit one copy of the application materials to the designated individual ON or BEFORE the established deadline. Applications with a postmarked or e-mailed deadline date will be accepted. In the event of a tie, the winner is to be decided based on demonstrated financial need. Please supply information on the types and amounts of financial aid received in the previous 12 months, or other pertinent information.
