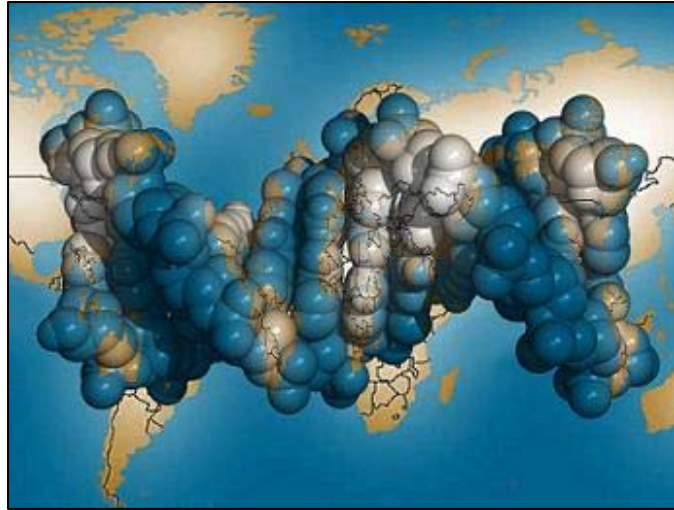

Paul Kei Matsuda is an Associate Professor of English. His research centers around second language writing, an interdisciplinary field of inquiry that integrates theoretical and methodological insights from both Linguistics and Rhetoric/Composition. Paul is founding chair of the Symposium on Second Language Writing and the CCCC Committee on Second Language Writing. He has also served as the Chair of the Nonnative English Speakers in TESOL Caucus. He has edited numerous books and special journal issues on second language writing. He is also the series editor of Parlor Press Series on Second Language Writing.

Paul's work appears in journals such as *College Composition and Communication*, *College English*, *Composition Studies*, *Computers and Composition*, *English for Specific Purposes*, and the *International Journal of Applied Linguistics*.
