Scholarship Application

The ASU Center for Nonprofit Leadership & Management has a limited number of partial scholarships that will be awarded for the Annual Nonprofit Conference. The purpose of the scholarships is to afford access to this educational opportunity to nonprofit and community leaders who otherwise would not be able to attend.

The scholarship award will cover all but \$25 of the total registration fee for the conference. Scholarship recipients will also have the opportunity to add on a pre-conference workshop at the discounted rate of \$25 (50% off).

Staff and board members of nonprofit organizations are encouraged to apply. Priority will be given to senior level staff and board member applicants from small to medium sized organizations. Preference will also be given to applicants representing organizations located outside of Maricopa County.

Please print out and complete the Scholarship Application form and attach your responses to the required questions on a separate piece of paper. Your responses need not be lengthy but should directly respond to the questions posed. Please remember that the requests for scholarships will likely exceed the number available – and the decision to award opportunities will be based on the criteria listed above and your response. To be eligible - applications must be received in the Center's office by **November 10, 2005**.
