The Tools Cluster Fair and Reception – Hosted by the W.K. Kellogg Foundation will feature national resource organizations. On Thursday, Juan Johnson, Vice President of The Coca-Cola Company and President of their Diversity Leadership Academy will present Leveraging Diversity as a Strategic Asset. On Friday Dr. Paul Light, Senior Fellow, Brookings Institution Scholar and founder and Director of the Center for Public Service – will present The State of our Nonprofit Workforce.

The Executive Director of the Year Award will also be presented during Nonprofit Day by The Organization for Nonprofit Executives (ONE).
