

TABLE: FACILITY

What is the Facility Table?

This table contains data about any physical structure, building, or site required by ASU for the performance of programs and related activities. This table is built from the production Facilities database. It contains one record per facility.

The following types of facilities will be found in this table.

- BUILDING – A roofed, walled facility providing permanent shelter for persons, animals, or equipment. For example: the Computing Commons
- STRUCTURE – A physical facility other than a building providing support for ASU's programs and related activities. For example: Parking Structures
- SITE – An outdoor facility required by ASU for the performance of programs and related activities. For example: sports fields

What is the key (unique identifier for a row) for Facility?

Facility Code

What is the timing of the Facility table?

This table is refreshed nightly from the Facilities production database.

Why would you use it?

This table contains the official code (number), official name, and official abbreviation for all campus facilities.

TABLE: FACILITY FLOOR

What is the Facility Floor table?

This table contains data about the assignable and non-assignable interior spaces of the floor of a facility. The table contains one record per facility floor. There may be several floors per facility. The table is built from data in the Facilities database.

What is the key (unique identifier for a row) for Facility Floor?

Facility Code and Facility Floor Level Code

What is the timing of the table?

This table is refreshed nightly from the Facilities production database.

Why would you use it?

You would use this table to find aggregate information about a specific floor of a facility.

TABLE: FACILITY ROOM

What is the Facility Room table?

This table contains data about all rooms that are in the production Facilities database. There is one record in the table per room. There can be many rooms in a facility.

What is the key (unique identifier for a row) for Facility Room?

Facility Code and Room

What is the timing of the table?

This table is refreshed nightly from the Facilities production database.

Why would you use it?

This table will tell you the square footage of a room, the official room number, if it is a cubicle or host room, and how the room is classified for use. The classification (PEFI code) tells if it is a classroom, laboratory, office, etc.

What should you watch out for?

Remember to pay attention to the Room Square Foot Category Code to eliminate duplicating counts for rooms that may be in the table two ways. One room number may be designated as a host room (HST) which means there are cubicles within the room. There may also be an entry in the table with a different room number for each cubicle (CUB) within the host room.

If you want to compare rooms in this table to classrooms in SIS, use the Facility Abbreviation to match to the building code in SIS.

TABLE: FACILITY ROOM EMPLOYEE

What is the Facility Room Employee table?

This table contains data about what employees are assigned to what rooms. The data comes from the production Facilities database.

What is the key (unique identifier for a row) for Facility Room Employee?

Facility Code, Room, and Affiliate ID

What is the timing of the table?

This table is refreshed nightly from the Facilities production database.

Why would you use it?

You can use this table to find out what employees are assigned to a specific room or what rooms are assigned to an employee.

What should you watch out for?

There can be multiple employees assigned to a room. An employee can be assigned to multiple rooms. Check the Primary Room Flag to determine if a room is the primary room for an employee.

The FTE percentage in the table is the percent time a person is employed according to HR. It doesn't have anything to do with percent time in a room.

You wouldn't want to use this table to physically locate a person as the data may only be as current as of the last survey date which is done in the late fall.

TABLE: FACILITY ROOM ACCOUNT

What is the Facility Room Account table?

This table contains data about what accounts are assigned to what rooms. The data comes from the production Facilities database. Only rooms that have organized research activity will have an associated account.

What is the key (unique identifier for a row) for Facility Room Account?

Facility Code, Room, and Account

What is the timing of the table?

This table is refreshed nightly from the Facilities production database.

Why would you use it?

You could use this table to find the account or financial manager assigned to a room.

What should you watch out for?

While there may be multiple accounts assigned to a room, the system doesn't contain information about percentages assigned to each account for the room.

If no accounts are present for a room it is because the room shows no research utilization.

TABLE: SPACE SURVEY COORDINATOR

What is the Space Survey Coordinator table?

This table contains data about the space coordinator assigned to each department. The data comes from the production Facilities database.

What is the key (unique identifier for a row) for Space Survey Coordinator?

Affiliate ID and HR Department Code

What is the timing of the table?

This table is refreshed nightly from the Facilities production database.

Why would you use it?

You would use this table to locate the space coordinator(s) for a particular department.

What should you watch out for?

A space coordinator may be assigned to multiple departments so there will be multiple records in this table for some people. You should also check the employee status to be sure that the person showing as coordinator is still an active employee. A department may also have multiple space coordinators assigned.
