Walker Mining District. --- at a meeting of the siners of Lynx Creckerd vicinity, sold gursuan to notice, on the 24th day of Movember, 1863, at the office of the Recorder, the following laws for the government of quartz mining, ere adopted:

Resolved. That the boundaries of this quartz mining and mineral district he as follows: viz, convencing at a hald mountain near the sink and to the west of Lynz Credi, running in a southerly direction following the dividing ridge of the vaters of the Abua Fria and Tasacyampa rivers, to a large pine mountain in an easterly direction from the place of convencent, thence in an easterly direction to the Agua Fria river, thence up the Agua Fria river, following the bod of the stream in a northerly direction to the Weelsey ranch, thence in a westerly direction to the place of beginning. An be it further resolved

Resolved. That the mame of this district be known as the Walker Quartz Mining District.

(Then follow the by-lawn.)
