4. Where did Sylvestre Andrade live in Arizona before he came to Florence? Mrs. T.A. Nicholas thinks that her father did not live at any place in Arizona before coming to Florence. That he came direct to Florence from Rayon, Sonora, Mexico. He probably lived in Vera Cruz, Mexico, before coming to Arizona. Am told that a daughter by the name of Susanna Puche has a store and lives in Nogales, Arizona. Could not get the names of Andrade Sylvestre's parents or date of his birth as Mrs. Nicholas and other old timers did not know them.

1. Ask Mrs. T. A. Nicholas to please give the names of his parents, the maiden name of his wife, when and where they were married, and the given name of Mrs. Joseph Spinas.

2. Search the files of the Florence newspapers for the obituary notices printed at the time of his death. Farish's History of Arizona states that he died about 1913.

Sylvestre Andrade died Friday, October 13, 1911, at age of 82 years, at Florence. One of first settlers in that section, had lived there greater part of his life.

--Arizona Blade-Tribune. October 21, 1911 (Just a notice in paper, no obituary)

Rafael Andrade inherits all of the estate of his father Sylvestre Andrade.

No mention of a daughter in papers.
