

BERRY, CHRISTIAN

Born at Charleston, Charleston County, South Carolina _____, 1830.

Enrolled November 10 at Bear Valley, Mariposa County, California, and mustered in at San Francisco, December 9, 1864, to serve 3 years as Private, Captain James W. Smith's Company H, 7th California Infantry; age at enlistment, 34; remained in San Francisco until May, 1865, and then went with the Company to Fort Yuma; on escort duty to Fort Mason, A.T., from November 28, 1865, to sometime in January, 1866; honorably discharged at Drum Barracks, Wilmington, Los Angeles County, California, March 30, 1866.

Was residing at Culling's Well, Yuma County, A.T., in February, 1891, and died there in March or April, 1898; War Department headstone at his grave at Culling's Well.
