Appointed Acting Midshipman, U. S. Navy, March 4, 1823; on May 27, he was ordered to proceed by water from Washington, Mason County, Kentucky, to New Orleans, Louisiana, where he received his warrant; attached to the West Indian Squadron, July 30, 1824; directed to be ready for exploring expedition, December 4, 1828; commissioned Lieutenant June 21, 1852; served on the VINCENNES, LEVANT, ERIE, OHIO, and CONGRESS and was in command of the PETREL.

Joined a party for California at Camp Ringgold, Texas, March 19, 1849; went with J. W. Audubon across morthern Mexico O md what is now southern Arizona and arrived San Diego November 4; went via Los Angeles and the San Joaquin Valley with 10 men and 46 mules and arrived at San Francisco, December 21, 1849; left for the gold fields December 28; reported to Commodore Jones for duty with the Pacific squadron, January 30, 1850, Drowned off Trinidad River (or Bay) California, March 87, 1850.
