

CAPRON, JOHN GIFFIELD
Swanton, Franklin County, Vermont
Born at Amboy, ~~Lebanon~~ County, Ohio, March 5, 1829.

Son of John and Electa (Babcock) Capron, married (1) Sarah Kesser at Tucson, 1860, from whom he was divorced by special Act of the 1st Arizona Legislature, October 13, 1864. (2) Mariett Leodora Fox (1838-1916) in Ohio, 1879.

Came to Arizona with the Overland Mail Co., 1857, listed, Territorial Census, 1864, at Tucson; resident in Arizona 6 years; occupation, Merchant; property valued at \$10,000.

Died at San Diego, California, September ⁷/₈, 1914, aged 85.

Buried Greenwood Cemetery, San Diego, California.

San Diego paper (no date): Death; came to San Diego, 1859; mail contractor, Los Angeles-El Paso; when Santa Fe entered San Diego put up warehouse and did contracting; "several years ago entered into agreement with Paradise Valley Sanitarium to erect dormitory for nurses in memory of his wife, asking only that three rooms be reserved for him for the remainder of his life.

At National City, Sept. 7, 1914, uncle of Mrs. W.H. Hiltz of San Diego, native of Vt.

San Diego paper (no date): Funeral and biog.: held mail contract Los Angeles-El Paso, drove Yuma stage, built warehouse in San Diego, contractor, relatives - a brother, Thos. Capron, Vt., a niece, Minnie R. Capron, Vt., a nephew, Chas. Capron, Malone, N.Y., and a nephew, Myron B. Capron, Melbourne, Ia.
