and was stationed at Camp _____ until March 1, 1862 when he left with
the Vanguard of the California Column to march eastward via Fort Yuma and the
Gila River route; severely wounded in the _____ in an encounter with
secessionists at Picacho Pass April 15, 1862; left there with other members
of the detachment who retreated to the Pima Villages, arriving April 24;
sick in hospital at _____ from _____ to
_____ 1862; honorably discharged on Surgeon's Certificate of
disability at Camp Drum, Wilmington, California, January 6, 1863.
