T., age 60, born in Maryland, occupation - Farmer; the following announcement of his death was printed in the Prescott Arizona Miner of July 23, 1870:

Girard Johnson died at Ft. Whipple Hospital, July 15, 1870, aged 68 years. Mr. Johnson was a native of Baltimore, Maryland, and came to Arizona from California in 1863. His loss will be much felt in this community, where he will long be remembered as a very industrious, energetic man and good citizen.
