Was the oldest child of the family and moved with his parents to Missouri; went to California in 1849; came to the Colorado River gold placers late in 1862 to join his cousin, William K. Henninger; listed, Territorial Consus. April. 1864, at Castle Dome, occupation - Minor, resident in Arisona 16 months; clerk of the District Court at La Pas, 1864-65; appointed by Governor Goodwin as Sheriff of Yuma County on May 22, 1865, to succeed Cornelius Sage, killed by Epaches; served as Deputy Sheriff in 1866; Member from Yuna County H. Of R., 2d Territorial Legislature, 1865; Member from Yuna County, 3d and 4th Territorial Councils, 1866-67; appointed Notary Public for Time County by Governor McCornick, February 1, 1866; Member from Pina County, 5th Territorial Council, 1868. In 1867 he wrote an account of the discovery of placer gold near la Pas which was printed in J. Ross Brown's report on the Mineral Resources of the Pacific Slope: the Arisona Kiner published an item on June 7, 1877, stating that "negotiations are pending for the sale of Alex Mokey's interest in the Gerro Colorado Mines for \$30,000."

Died at Tueson, Pina County, A. T., December 12, 1860, aged 53; buried in old city Cometary, Tueson.
