

**NINWOLD, CHARLES**

Born at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, June 25, 1839.  
Son of Thomas Newbold and Julia —  
<sup>age 35</sup> <sub>1850 Census</sub> <sup>age 31</sup>  
Married Frances Kemper Lowe at Dayton, Ohio  
on December 28, 1865.

Children, Henry Lowe (Captain, U.S. Army, 1912.)

As 2d Lieutenant, 5th U.S. Infantry, he was stationed in New Mexico and participated in campaign against Navajo Indians, 1863; resigned, November 18, 1867; Paymaster, U.S. Army, 1899-1903; retired, June 25, 1903.

Died at Truckee, California, on September 16, 1908, aged 69.

Buried Arlington Cemetery, Washington, D.C., September 21, 1908.
