Funeral services for George Cswald, 84 years old, pioneer Yavapai county rancher who was burned to death on the S. A. D. Jackson ranch in Walmut Grove Monday (March 30) will be held at 2 o'clock this afternoon in Walnut Grove.

Oswald was engaged in cutting corn fodder on the ranch owned by a half brother. He took his lunch with him to the field and is believed to have seated himself in the grass to eat it.

A ranch hand found the body shortly after one o'clock burned to a crisp. It is thought that the aged rancher's clothing must have become ignited while he was taking a map after eating his lunch, as the grass around his body had been burned away. A pipe was found beside him and it is probable that it caused the fire.
