SALESARA, FRANCISCO, born in San Jose, Costa Rica, Central America, 1841; enrolled at Placerville, Eldorado County, California, March 11, 1864; and mustered in as Private, Company B, 1st Battalion Native California Cavalry at San Francisco, California, April 9, 1864, to serve three years; occupation when enlisted, laborer; served at the Presidio of San Francisco until January, 1865; stationed at Camp Low, California, until June, 1865; marched via Fort Yuma and died of disease in camp near Gila City, Yuma County, Arizona Territory, August 8, 1865, aged 24.
