We should have announced in our last the recent death of two individuals well known in Prescott and formerly residing here. Mr. Robert Short died at his ranch in Skull Valley, of congestive chills, and William Prideaux, whose last position here was that of cook for Mr. Brown and who accompanied Mr. Brown and Captain Tuttle to Fort Yuma, was drowned in the river near that place.
