Emigrated to America 1835; marched across Southern Arizona as a soldier in Captain D. C. Davis' Company E, Mormon Battalion, 1846; returned to Arizona 1880 and settled at Alma, near Mesa, in Maricopa County; kept a journal of his experiences from June 5, 1846, to July 23, 1847, which was printed in 1928 under the title of The March of the Mormon Battalion.

Died at Mesa, Maricopa County, A. T., May 8, 1899, aged 81.
