WARD, HENRY McO \_\_\_\_\_, born at \_\_\_\_\_, Prince  
George's County, Maryland, \_\_\_\_\_, 18 \_\_\_\_\_ (about 1838);

Enlisted, age 22, at Baltimore, Maryland, on March 18, 1856,  
to serve 5 years as Private, Company F, 1st U.S. Dragoons; discharged  
at Fort Thorn, New Mexico, September 30, 1856; cause of discharge  
not found, but reference has been found to a letter from his mother.  
This letter has not been located, but it is thought she may have  
requested his discharge because he was under age when enlisted with-  
out her consent.

Came to Arizona in 1856; listed, Territorial Census, April,  
1864, at Tucson, age 26, born in Maryland, occupation, Customs House  
Officer; member H. of R., 3d Territorial Legislature, from Babacomori,  
Pima County, age 29, born in Maryland, occupation, Contractor, attended  
the session at Prescott in October, 1866; the Arizona Miner states  
that he belonged to a prominent family in Maryland.

Died at Tucson, Pima County, A. T. January 19, 1870.
