Ella, (Mrs. _____) and James or Santiago, a member of the A.P.H.S. who was born at Sonoita on July 25, 1860, and who died at Tucson, October 9, 1935.

Came to Arizona, 1858; listed, U.S. Census, 1860, at Sonoita Creek Settlement, age 54, born in Ireland, occupation, Farmer, property valued at \$2,000; Territorial Census, April, 1864, at Tucson, age 57, occupation, Glassblower, resident in Arizona 6 years.

Raphael Pumpelly describes him as an old frontiersman who accompanied him from Fort Buchanan to the Santa Rita Mines in May, 1861, when they narrowly escaped ambush by Apaches.
