

WICKENBURG, HENRY

Born at _____ Prussia, Germany, November _____ 19, _____ 1819.

Son of _____ and _____.

Came from California to La Paz, 1862; discovered the Vulture Mine, October, 1863; listed, Territorial Census, 1864, at both Pima Villages and 3d District (Yavapai County), A.T. Age 45, (35) born in Prussia, Germany; Occupation, (Transient) Miner, resident in Arizona 18 months, property valued at \$700; U. S. Census, August 26, 1870, age 50, born in Germany Occupation, Farmer.

Died near Wickenburg, Maricopa County, A.T., May 14, 1905, Aged 85.

Buried on the mesa west of his old house (Monument).

The town of Wickenburg, Arizona, named for him.
