Born in Kontucky on the divide between the Graen and Cumberland Rivers about 1830; probnbly a son of William 0. and Nancy Whest of Adair County, Kontucky; married by a Priost to Tomasa Montogn at FLorence, A.T., January 27, 2874; adopted daughters, Louisa Coagrove and Mary Tumer (Mrb. Ignaoio Garoia).

Came from Caifromia to the Gadesden Purohase to work for the Butterfiola Sttge Line, 1859; 11sted, U. S. Census, 1860, at Tucson, age 30, born in Kentuoky, ocoupation - Trader; Perritorial Ceneus, 1864, at Pima Villages, age 34, born in Kentucky, occupation - Clerk; appointed by Oovernor Goodvin on February 5, 1866, to be member of the Board of Supervisors of Pime County; was in charge of trading post for J. H. Toole at Maricopa Crossing on the Oile River Indian Reservation.
'Settled on farm near florence in 1869, and the following year constructed aitch to conneot with the Holland Ditoh for the irrigation of hia land: 11sted, U. S. Census, 1870, at Florence, Plma County, A.T., gge 40, oocupation - Parmer, property valued at $\$ 1,100$; that same year he: arved as Constable Florence; on April 15, 1874, he obtained patent to quarter aection of land of which $64 \frac{1}{\mathrm{~L}}$ acres was platted as What's Addition to the Town of Florence on April 26, 1876; member of the Board of Supervisors of Pinal County, 1878-80; In a law suit with a neighbor involving a dispute over water right he mo an arfidavit on June 3, 1886, from which the following is quoted:

Affiant further states that the defendant is not responsible and wholly unable and without the means to pay plaintiffs for the use of said water or any damages ocasioned by his wrongful diversion thereof. What title property he has is exempt from execution and used as residence or homestead of no great value. Plaintiffs expect to have to
pay the costs of this action though successful there being no earthly show to make it out of Douglas. Any judgment obtained against Douglas will be of no particular value to plaintiffs for the time being and perhaps never. The prevention of the diversion of the water by defendant and the damages flowing therefrom is the main object of this suit.

Sorved as Road Overseer of District Number 1 in Pinal County, 1899-1900 and as Justice of the Peace for Florence Precinct from January 1, 1905 to January 1, 1908; died at Florence, Pinal County, A.T., December 11, 1911, aged 81; buried, Forence Cemetary, 2 miles south of the town.
