

WAIPPLE, WILLIAM DEMISON

Born at Nelson, Madison Co. , New York, August 8, 1826. Son of <u>Jeremiah Whipple</u> and <u>Jerusha (Murdock) Whipple</u>.

(Jeremiah Whipple, Sullivan, <u>Madison</u> <u>C</u>ounty, N.Y., P or G, 1847) Married, Mary Cooke of Norristown, Penna., December 16, 1854. Children

Appointed from New York to West Point, 1847; graduated 1851. Came to New Mexico as 2d Lieutenant, 3d U.S. Infantry, 1852; in combat with Coystero and Mogollon Apaches on the Gila River north of Mount Turnbull, June 27, 1857; stationed at Fort Defiance, 1858-60, and engaged in skirmish with hostile Indians near there, May 30, 1858; convoying wagon trains and participated in defense of that Post, April 30, 1860.

Died at <u>New York City</u>, <u>New York</u>, April 1, 1902, aged 75. Buried <u>Arlington NationalCemetery</u>, <u>Arlington</u>, <u>Virginia</u>. <u>SOURCES OF INFORMATION</u>
