Entered U. S. Military Academy July 1, 1849; graduated and appointed 2d Lieutenant, 3d U. S. Artillery, July 1, 1853; served against Seminole Indians in Florida, 1853-54; at Fort Snelling, Minnesota, 1854-55; promoted 1st Lieutenant, November 11, 1856; in expedition against Puget Sound Indians 1856; stationed at Fort Yuma, 1857-58; in command of escort of 15 soldiers on the steamboat General Jessup which went up from Fort Yuma to ferry Lieutenant E. F. Beal's expedition across the Colorado River near site of Fort Mohave, January 24, 1858.

Resigned March 3, 1861, to join the Confederate Army.

Died at _____ November 24, 1894.
