Emrolled at Nevada City, Nevada County, California, November 1 and mustered in at Camp Union, near Sacramento, November 18, 1861, to serve 3 years as Private, Captain Charles Atchisson's Company I, 4th California Infantry; occupation when enlisted - Miner; stationed there until June, 1862, and at Benecia Barracks until March, 1863; went with the Company to Southern California and was at Fort Mohave, A.T., from June, 1853 to November, 1864; listed in the Territorial Comsus, 1864, at that Post as Soldier; honorably discharged at Drum Barracks, Les Angeles County, California, by expiration of enlistment, December 5, 1864.

Returned to Arisons and was listed, U.S. Consus, 1870, at Williamson
Valley, Yavapai County, occupation - Carpenter; the Prescott, Arisons Miner
of July 27, 1877, stated that he had returned from San Francisco after an
absence of nearly a year; worked at his trade at Prescott, Wickenburg and
Phoenix; with his brother, John, established a wheelwright and blacksmith
shop at Willcox, Cochise County about 1890; moved to Tucson, about 1902, where
he obtained employment as Carpenter at the Southern Pacific Railroad shops.

Member, Aztlan Lodge No. 177(1) F. and A.M., Prescott, 1882; Comrade, Negley Post No. 1, G.A.R., at Tucson, 1902; Member, Arizona Pioneers Historical Society at Tucson.

Died at Tucson, Pima County, A.T., July 4, 1911, aged 70; his remains were sent to Winfield, Cowley County, Kansas, for interment.
