Died at Canyon Diable, Coconino County, A.T., September 2, 1899. Buried at Canyon Diablo, Arizona.

His estate, consisting of merchandise, Navajo blankets, wool, pelts, hides, etc., at his trading post, was appraised at \$5,328.
