Borm at Aldame, Chihushua, Mexico, November 26, 1836
Son of Pedro and Maria del Regugio (Mendosa) Aguirre.

Married Carmen Elias of Magdalena, Sonora (no children).

Came to Las Cruces, New Mexico, with his parents, 1850;
assisted his brothers, Epifanic and Pedro in freighting
across the plains to the Missouri River; first came to Arizona
with them, 1864; they were operating a stage line between
Tucson and Altar, Sonora, when he and his brother Epifanic and
three others were attacked by Indians at Sasabi Flat on
January 20, 1870 and he was the sole survivor.

Died of a heart attack at Nogales, Pima County, A.T.,
August 1889.
