

SAMPLE LANGUAGE FOR RIDER RESERVING CERTAIN RIGHTS

It is generally acceptable to handwrite "Rider 1" under the appropriate provision in the original publishing agreement, and then attach the Rider as an addendum. It is of course preferable, and in some jurisdictions necessary, to have the Rider signed by both parties, in which case, signature lines should be included.

Rider 1

Notwithstanding any other provision to the contrary herein, Author retains the right to use the Work for non-commercial, personal, educational and/or research purposes. This includes the right to copy, distribute, modify, prepare derivative works, use in coursepacks, use in distance and/or web-based teaching, to archive electronically on personal, institutional and/or non-commercial educational websites and to republish in open-access forums. Author also retains these rights on behalf of [institution name]. This paragraph is not intended to limit or restrict any other rights the Author may have under the provisions of this Agreement or the Fair Use provisions of the Copyright Act of 1976 (as amended).
