

# **MONTREAL SUMMER LITERARY SEMINAR INTERNATIONAL FELLOWSHIP**

## **DESCRIPTION**

The Piper Center for Creative Writing's Program for Global Engagement has begun a new partnership this year with the Summer Literary Seminars (<http://www.sumlitsem.org/>), and from June 13-27, 2010, will send 2 MFA students to Montreal to participate in classes and lectures and readings with this summer's faculty.

## **WHO CAN APPLY**

All currently enrolled MFA students in creative writing are eligible to apply.

## **AWARD AMOUNT**

\$500 SLS grant (approximately)

\$2,500 Piper Global Fellowship

(amount subject to change based on current airfare prices and estimated costs)

Fellowship covers airfare, accommodation, personal living expenses, and transportation; all costs that exceed the fellowship amount will be at the student's expense. This fellowship is not intended to cover 100% of costs. Visa, passport, and immunization fees will be at the student's expense.

## **SPECIAL COMMITMENTS**

Within thirty days of returning from fellowship commitments, students will need to submit an essay about their international fellowship experience and a program evaluation. Late responses will render students ineligible for future fellowships.

All fellowship applicants and awardees are encouraged to take the Spring course, Gateway to Global Engagement.
