

## **INTERNATIONAL TEACHING FELLOWSHIP – SINGAPORE**

### **DESCRIPTION**

The Singapore teaching fellowship is Piper Global's longest running international program, now going into its fifth year. During the summer of 2010, two ASU MFA students will have the opportunity to live in Singapore and teach creative writing classes for honors undergraduate and high school students at the National University of Singapore (NUS). The 6-week undergraduate course meets twice a week, and the high school course runs for two weeks.

### **WHO CAN APPLY**

All currently enrolled MFA students in creative writing are eligible to apply.

### **AWARD AMOUNT**

\$4,000 Piper Global Fellowship

(amount subject to change based on current airfare prices and estimated costs)

Apartment provided by NUS (\$1,800 value)

Fellowship covers airfare, some personal living expenses, utilities (estimated: \$300), bus/train transportation; all costs that exceed the fellowship amount will be at the student's expense.

### **SPECIAL COMMITMENTS**

Within thirty days of returning from fellowship commitments, students will need to submit an essay about their international fellowship experience and a program evaluation. Late responses will render students ineligible for future fellowships.

All fellowship applicants and awardees are encouraged to take the Spring course, Gateway to Global Engagement.
