Meat Stone

in the raw material of inorganic stone

the artist saw not mineral but animal

strata defined by bands of color, striated quartz

a lattice of atoms in agate, or *chalcedon*

a fantasy of corpulence – not the actual thing itself

but the body's carcass carved & stewed

in its own juices

the Greek bachelor Pygmalion longed

to breathe being into modeled marble

no small commitment to life

nourishing words w/marrow & meat,

stone skinned alive, flesh of fatty pork

feeds gray matter acts upon the heart

served under glass letter for letter each gnaw & chew of language even the herbivore imagines
