Golf Cart theft has raised dramatically on the Tempe campus.

The golf cart thefts are occurring over night and on the week ends. New and old carts are being stolen. All the carts have been recovered on campus, some with damage. No suspects have been identified at this time.

PROTECT YOUR CART

1. When the cart is secured for the day secure it to a solid object with a heavy chain.
2. Invest in a Club-type device to secure the steering wheel, or an ignition collar locking device. While they can be defeated it takes time. **These devices are an excellent deterrent to theft.**
3. If possible park the cart in a locked fenced area.
