Course Description:

The course will provide an introduction to the theory, methods, techniques, and tools used to restore and enhance watershed health. We will investigate watershed function; introductory stream hydrology and morphology; and fish, amphibian and aquatic habitat characteristics. The course also explores human impacts on watershed and stream function, as well as on fish habitat and fish populations. The course includes field reconnaissance of a watershed and students learn to gather field data and develop a watershed restoration plan.
