Terms and Conditions

About the Scholarship Program:

The Make It So Foundation scholarship was established in 1999 by donors who wish to remain anonymous, exclusively for Native American students returning to study for whom funding will bridge a financial gap that may otherwise prevent the student from continuing his or her studies.

Eligibility:

- Native American student, undergraduate or graduate.
- Returning student who successfully completed at least one semester of postsecondary education, has had his or her education interrupted with at least a one year gap in studies and has returned or is returning to studies.
- Financial need as determined by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (www.fafsa.ed.gov/).
- Full-time student at Arizona State University, Northern Arizona University or the University of Arizona.

Award:

A one time award of \$1,500 distributed in two equal payments before the start of each semester. A student may apply and be considered year after year, but there is no automatic renewal of the scholarship for previously awarded students.

Application Process:

Complete the attached application form and mail it, along with the **required essays**, a **current transcript** (unofficial or official) and a copy of the **Student Aid Report showing the EFC** for 2009-10 to the address below.

The application materials must arrive at the Arizona Community Foundation Scholarship Office no later than May 1, 2009
