

Spring 2008 Tuition Refund Schedule

Term Classes and Sessions Longer Than Eight Weeks

Tuition charges are subject to 100% refund during the first two weeks of the regular semester and during the first two weeks of sessions that are eight weeks or longer. Tuition is **nonrefundable** thereafter. All refunds are less any amounts owed to the university and are subject to payment holding periods.

Note 1: Beginning with the first day of the term, undergraduate students are required to request complete withdrawal in person; withdrawal from all classes is not permitted online. To receive a 100% refund, complete withdrawal must be completed in person by Friday, January 25.

Drop, withdrawal, or cancellation occurs on the calendar day that withdrawal is processed, either in person at a Registrar site or online. Students are required to pay tuition and fees owed for enrollment cancellations that occur after the first two weeks. By registering for classes students agree to pay all applicable tuition and registration fees.

Sessions Shorter Than Eight Weeks and Dynamically Dated Classes

The 100% refund period is one week for sessions shorter than eight weeks and dynamically dated classes. Tuition is **nonrefundable** after the first week.

Medical Withdrawals

Students withdrawing for medical circumstances must contact their college to initiate the process. Approved medical withdrawals are eligible for up to an 80% refund of tuition if approved within two years of the end of the semester. No tuition refund is provided thereafter.
