

## Message from ISO- Spring Break Travel Advisory/ WORLD FESTIVAL 2009

### I. SPRING BREAK TRAVEL

- If you are planning to travel out of the country, do not forget to check p.3 of your form I-20 or p.1 of your DS-2019 and make sure that you have a travel endorsement within the year. If you need a new signature, bring your I-20 to the ISO as soon as possible! ISO processing time is 10-14 working days so please plan accordingly. *Students on OPT must have a valid signature for 6 months. Fulbright sponsored students must contact IIE directly for travel signature information.* For complete international travel reminders, please visit the ISO website <http://asu.edu/international/travel.html>
- If you are travelling within the USA, no need for a travel signature but you must carry identification documents with you: I-20/DS-2019, I-94, valid Passport. There are various checkpoints within the U.S. manned by United States Customs and Border Protection (USCBP).
